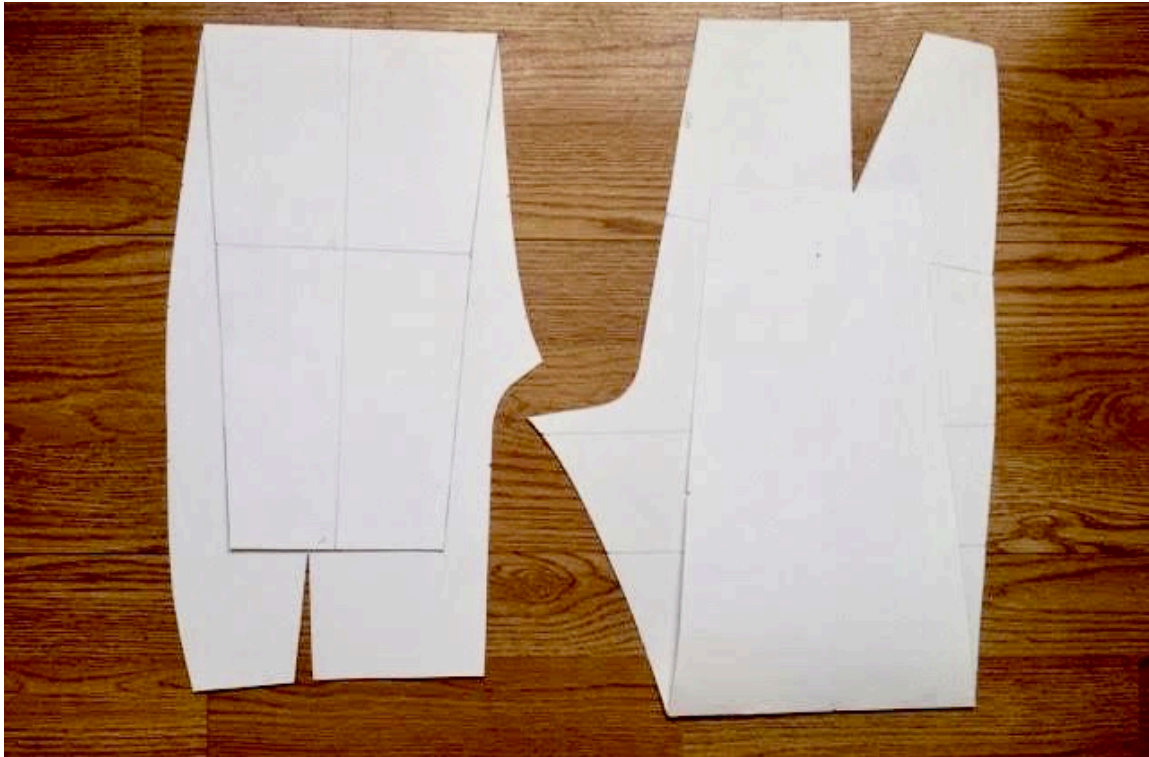


Student Strategies from Najah:



Though I had heard good things about using oil cloth for blocks, I did not end up preferring it to using thick paper. Sheets of posterboard/cardstock are usually too small for pants blocks but Najah solved the problem. She used 2 large sheets for both the front and the back and created a taped hinge at each knee!

Here you can see Najah's folded finalized jeans block transferred to 4 sheets of thick paper with a taped hinge along the knee line. She can unfold the hinges when drafting and fold them up to store them away.
